

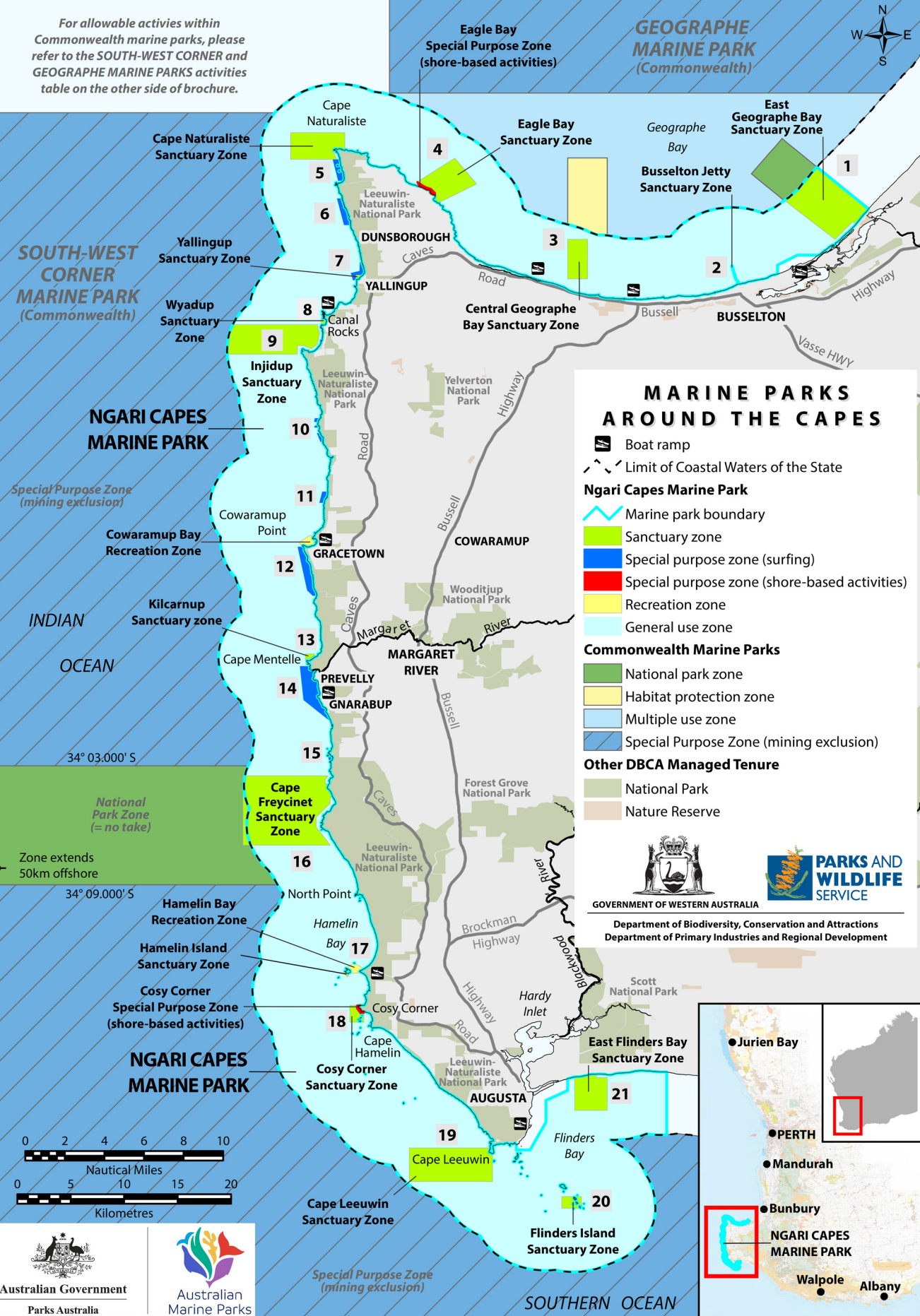

- A fishing licence is required for fishing from powered boats. Recreational fishing rules apply including bag and size limits, species and gear restrictions. For further details visit [www.fish.wa.gov.au](http://www.fish.wa.gov.au)
- Recreational fishing from a licenced charter boat is not allowed in this zone.
- A fishing licence is required and seasonal closures apply. For further details visit [www.fish.wa.gov.au](http://www.fish.wa.gov.au)
- Fishing for any species associated with the use of a boat is not allowed in shore-based activities zone.
- The use of pots to recreationally fish for rock lobster in surfing zones is only allowed within the Margaret River Special Purpose Zone (surfing).
- The use of pots or traps to fish for rock lobster or octopus is not allowed in the small General Use Zone adjacent to Cape Naturaliste.
- Recreational set netting is not allowed within the Ngari Capes Marine Park. A fishing licence is required for the use of all other nets and restrictions apply within certain areas of the marine park.
